Primary 6 Students Dive into Fascinating Oceans on RTHK Radio

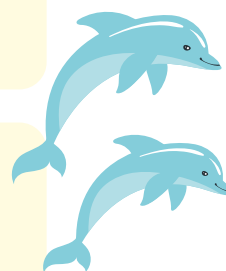
