#### **Proposal for the One-off Grant for Promotion of Self-directed Language Learning (English Language)**

Ref.: EDB(CD)CLE/FIN/65/28PTH(SDL)

#### **Objectives of the Grant:**

- 1. Provide schools with additional resources to strengthen students' self-directed language learning capabilities so as to improve their English proficiency
- 2. Enable schools to establish a language-rich environment that facilitates students' learning

#### **Details of the Grant:**

- 1. One-off grant of \$200,000 funded by Language Fund and endorsed by SCOLAR for each public sector primary school and DSS school offering local curriculum in the 2024/25 school year.
- 2. Schools can flexibly deploy the Grant until the end of the 2026/27 school year.
- 3. Schools may combine other subsidies from the EDB and other resources on a need basis to cover the relevant costs.
